

Important Municipal Notification for All Bicycle Users in Toyota City, as of April 1, 2020

This information is a bit dated, however, there's a relatively new law of which bicycle users in Toyota City must be aware. Effective April 1, 2020, it has become mandatory for cyclists to wear a helmet, and to enroll in a bicycle insurance (Personal Injury Insurance). Also, as of October 1, 2020, the law of enrollment in a bicycle insurance plan took effect as a means of traffic safety. Everyone appreciates the convenience of having bicycles to get us around whether for running errands, sporting, or as a means of transportation to and from work. This very convenience gives rise to an increase in road accidents, which has probably made it necessary to regulate the use of bicycles. You are also being urged to familiarize yourself with the traffic rules for bicycles, which include refraining from riding on sidewalks, riding on the left-hand-side of the roadway, giving priority to pedestrians and keeping to the side of the road, the need to use lights at night, as well as observing the traffic lights, road signs and symbols.

It is imperative that we adhere to these mandates. You can also scan the QR code on the right using a code reader application, or your phone camera, to gain access to an elaborate and easily understandable YouTube video, which offers scenarios depicting the right and wrong ways to ride your bicycle along the city's roadways.



Please check out these available tools to educate ourselves so we do not to end up on the wrong side of the law or injured.

Regarding the Use of TIA, & Important Information in Relation to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Pandemic

- It is mandatory for everyone using the facilities of TIA to wear a mask and disinfect their hands when entering and leaving the premises.
- · Those who turn up without a mask will be required to make one using a basic kit provided at the entrance of the building, if they want to enter the premises.
- You are required to have a handkerchief on your person, and please use it to cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze.
- The capacity of the meeting rooms and gathering spaces has been reduced to 1/2 the regular number, with individual seating to be placed about 1 meter apart.
- · Avoid direct or indirect contact, and sharing items with other users outside of your family is not recommended.
- To avoid crowding, parents or acquaintances who come to pick up or drop someone off are being asked to wait outside in the car, or at a different location.
- If you are sick and have a fever of over 37.5 degrees Celsius, please refrain from participating in the programs being held at TIA until you're fully recovered.
